Entry Info: * If only one cat/kitten is being entered a double cage *must* be purchased. Entries accepted now. Entry fees include CFA surcharges. Per show rule 6.21 each entry must be accompanied by the stipulated entry fee. All entries must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first. **Check your confirmation for accuracy and contact the entry clerk with corrections BEFORE THE CLOSING DATE.** No substitutions after the closing date. **NO REFUNDS AFTER YOUR ENTRY HAS BEEN CONFIRMED OR FOR FAILURE TO ATTEND THE SHOW.** By entering exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the judges and the show committee and to adhere to CFA show rules. CFA show rules may be obtained from CFA, www.cfa.org

Show Hall: Old Main Building @ York Expo Center 334 Carlisle Ave. York, PA 17404 Ph: 717-848-2596. The show hall is handicapped accessible and is heated and air-conditioned as needed. People food will be available. Parking is free.

Scoring: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of cats/kittens without registration numbers can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number.

Check-in: 8 – 9 am **Judging Hours:** 9:30 am – 4:30 pm (or at completion of finals)

Household Pets: All entries must be at least 4 months old; all entries 8 months or older must be neutered or spayed. Entries may not be declawed.

Benching: Single cage size is approximately 22"x22"x22" and is included with your entry fee. Litter will be provided, bring cage curtains (or coverings) to cover the sides, top and bottom of cage. Kittens under 4 months are not permitted in the show hall or on the show grounds. No cats or kittens may be left in the show hall overnight. Only benched cats and kittens are permitted in the show hall, none may be confined in carriers.

Health: It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All claws of all entries must be clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition.
